## LEARNING POINTS - FULL-ARCH REHABILITATION & IMMEDIATE LOADING

Participants will be exposed to a wide variety of full-arch clinical scenarios, from straightforward to complex cases.

### Diagnosis & Planning

- Case selection, risk assessment, and complication prevention CBCT-based planning
- and prosthetically driven decision-making Flap design and soft tissue management
- Implant positioning strategies for full-arch rehabilitation (axial and tilted concepts)
- Bone reduction (alveoloplasty) and prosthetic space management Primary stability
- protocols and intraoperative decision-making Management of challenging cases
- (atrophy, poor bone quality, anatomical limitations)

### Immediate Loading & Provisional Prosthesis

- Criteria and safety thresholds for immediate loading
- Multi-unit selection and screw-retained provisional workflow
- Occlusal principles for provisional full-arch restorations
- Troubleshooting and management of intra/post-operative complications
